I am writing to inform you of the decision taken by the Canadian Human Rights Commission in your complaint (20060962) against Canadian Forces.


Before rendering its decision, the Commission reviewed the analysis and the recommendation contained in the letter sent to you previously by the Investigations Branch, and any submission(s) filed in response to the letter. After examining this information, the Commission decided, pursuant to paragraph 41(1)(a) of the *Canadian Human Rights Act*, not to deal with the complaint at this time because

- the complainant ought to exhaust grievance or review procedures otherwise available. At the termination of these procedures, or if they prove not to be reasonably available, the Commission may exercise its discretion to deal with the complaint at the complainant's request.

Please note that, if you are not satisfied with the final outcome and you wish to pursue the matter, you must contact the Commission as soon as possible.
